A broad lace for Parses of Seven bowes.

C. of thy right hand, and two sundry bowes upon B. thy lest hand and other two sundry, upon B. of thy lest hand and one upon C. of the same hand, and then shall you take vith A. of thy right hand thorough B. C. of the selfe hand, the boy v that is uttermost upon B. lest unreversed, and B. right shall take the boy ve utterest upon B. lest unreversed, and thorough the lest boy ve utterest upon B. lest unreversed, and thorough the lest boy ve A. right shall take the boy ve C. lest unreversed. And take good care that the boy ves that are on any singer meng them not, and then love thy boy ves of thy lest hand, and then shalt thou take vith A. of thy lest hand thorough B. C. of the selfe hand, the Boy that is uttermost upon B. right reversed, and B. lest, shall take the boy ve that is uttermost upon A. right unreversed, and thorough that selfe boy ve A. lest shall take the boy ve C. unteversed of the right hand, and lovy thy bowes, and then begin againe.

The same Lace open.

De in selse manner as is aforesaid save that never a bovve that he taken reversed, and if the bowes be departed that one shall be of one colour and thother of an other.

A Lace partie round.

Frall thy bowes be departed and fet upon thy hands as is aforefaid, and then work in the felfe manner, and what time then haft but two bowes upon thy one hand thou shalt turne the over bow of the selfe hand, so that the selfe colour that was afore the turning above is after the turning beneath.
